

Most faculty members at Arignar Anna Government Arts College in Namakkal are content with the courses' content, objectives, teaching resources, and balance between theory and application. They also appreciate the opportunity for applied learning and the appropriateness of the continuous assessment system.

However, some areas need improvement. These include the instructional hours, career orientation in the syllabus, and research facilities, which have received lower ratings from the faculty.

Action Taken Report:

Based on the faculty feedback provided, it appears that Arignar Anna Government Arts College in Namakkal is doing well in many areas of its academic programs, but several areas need

Introducing PhD programs in additional departments: The college administration and the departments applied for permission to start the doctoral programs in various departments. By considering the merits of our application, the government of Tamil Nadu permitted to start Ph.D. program in the department of mathematics.

Increasing access to international journals: The college subscribed for inflibnet facility in the library. So that the faculty, research scholars and students were given access to the numourous online books and journals with Inflibnet.

Improving the English proficiency of students: To enhance students' English proficiency, the English department has made English a mandatory subject in the curriculum. However, the effectiveness of the teaching methods used so far has not been sufficient. To address this issue, the department has implemented the use of a language lab to provide additional training to students. Additionally, the faculty is encouraging students to expand their vocabulary by writing down new English words.

Ensuring practical relevance of course content: To ensure that the course content remains practical and relevant, our college collaborates with the Periyar University, which has control over the curriculum. We have faculty members who are part of the Periyar University Board of Studies, and they present our proposed curriculum changes during the BOS meeting. Following the presentation, the BOS may approve some immediate modifications to the syllabus, allowing us to maintain the practicality and relevance of our courses.

Recruiting faculty for the BBA department: In order to recruit new faculty for the BBA department, our college took several steps. Firstly, we took into consideration the feedback we received and decided to appoint a temporary staff member under the PTA fund. Additionally, we reached out to the Directorate of Collegiate in Chennai to communicate our need for further action regarding the recruitment process.

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

According to the feedback, most faculty members rated the content of courses as very good or excellent. They also felt that the course objectives were clear, and advanced topics were included in the syllabus. Additionally, they were satisfied with the availability of teaching resources and reference books, the opportunity for applied learning, and the balance between theory and application.

However, some areas need improvement. A few faculty members felt that the syllabus should have more instructional hours and better career orientation. Additionally, the research facilities were not rated as highly as other areas.

The feedback suggests that the college is doing a good job in many areas, but there is room for improvement in someaspects.

Action Taken Report:

Based on the faculty feedback, the following actions may be taken to improve Arignar Anna Government Arts College:

Enhance the proficiency of students' communication skills: The college organised workshops and training sessions for students to improve their communication skills. The language lab in the Department of English is used to enhance the students' communication skills.

Expand the Ph.D program offerings: The college identified the departments with high research potential, initiated Ph.D. programs in those areas, and communicated the same to the directorate of collegiate education for permission to start a doctoral program. DCE's approval is awited.

Host National and International seminars: Various departments of our college organisedNational and International seminars with advanced topics. This also helped promote the college's brand and attract international collaborations.

Improve transportation facilities: After receiving feedback from students and faculty regarding the need to improve transportation facilities, the college administration took several steps to address the issue. The administration approached the State Transport Corporation to request more buses during college hours to accommodate the growing number of students and faculty. As a result of our request, the State Transport Corporation agreed to provide additional buses during college hours, ensuring safe and efficient transportation of our students and staff. The new buses were added in the morning and evening, helping students and faculty to arrive on time and return home safely. In addition, two separate buses were allocated for girl students to ensure their safety and comfort during their commute to and from the college.

Increase the number of classrooms: The college council requested the Government of Tamil Nadu DCF to provide more funds to increase the number of classrooms to accommodate new courses and students. By considering our request, the Government of Tamil Nadu sanctioned additional classrooms.

Provide additional training for job placements: The Placement cell organised placement training programs for students to help them prepare for job placements and career opportunities. This included training on interview skills, resume writing, and soft skills.

To Encourage students to enroll in UGC-accredited MOOC courses: All the departments spread the information related to MOOC courses and their importance. Some of our students enrolled in MOOC courses to enhance their knowledge and skills in their chosen fields.

Upgrade research laboratory facilities: By considering the need to upgrade the lab facilities, the administration approached DEC for further action. Permission was obtained to construct new Physics and Botany labs. The construction of new labs are in progress.

Establish a GIS and Remote Sensing lab: To establish a GIS and Remote Sensing lab, we request further action from the DCE. The results are awaited.

Establish a training centre: The Placement cell organise awareness programs for the students prepare for and succeed in competitive examinations, promoting career opportunities. Special coaching classes are also organised for the benefit of the students to face the competitive examinations. It receives a good responses.

Introduce the latest subjects and technologies: Since it is related Periyar University to take further action, we requested our needs to BOS meeting where our faculty are part of it.

Overall, by implementing these actions, Arignar Anna Government Arts College can address the areas for improvement identified by faculty feedback and enhance the college's reputation as a leading institution for higher education.

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

Based on the feedback, most faculty members rated the content of courses as very good or excellent, the course objectives were clear, and advanced topics were included in the syllabus. The availability of teaching resources and reference books, the opportunity for applied learning, and the balance between theory and application were also satisfactory. However, some areas need improvement. A few faculty members felt that the syllabus should have more instructional hours and better career orientation. Additionally, the research facilities were not rated as highly as other areas.

Overall, the feedback suggests that the college is doing a good job in many areas, but there is room for improvement in some aspects. The college can consider the feedback to further enhance the academic programs and facilities and ensure that students receive the best education possible.

Action Taken Report:

Open Ph.D. Programs: In response to the faculty feedback, the college administration has taken steps to open Ph.D. programs in departments where they have not yet been introduced. An application has been submitted to the Directorate of Collegiate Education (DCE) seeking approval for the new doctoral programs. We are currently awaiting a response from the DCE and will keep the faculty and students updated on any developments.

Conduct Seminars: The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college requested all departments and supporting services to conduct seminars and workshops. In response, various departments organised seminars and workshops during the academic year 2022-2023. These events provided opportunities for students and faculty to enhance their knowledge, share ideas, and promote a culture of research and innovation.

Improve Research Facilities: The college administration has taken steps to improve research facilities by upgrading laboratory equipment, and enhancing library resources.

Increase Laboratory and Classroom Facilities: In response to the feedback, the college administration has taken significant steps to improve laboratory and classroom facilities. The administration submitted a request to the government for additional infrastructure, and we are pleased to report that our request has been approved. A new building has been sanctioned to

accommodate the growing student population and provide state-of-the-art facilities for teaching and learning.

Provide Placement-Related Training: The placement cell of our college has taken initiatives to provide placement-related training for government jobs and self-employment. This year, the Government of Tamil Nadu introduced a soft-skill development program for the final year UG and PG students, which was coordinated by our Soft-skill training cell. This program helped our students to upgrade their knowledge and soft skills, enabling them to face job interviews and competitive examinations with greater confidence.

Provide More Reference Books: As part of the college's commitment to providing quality education, a separate budget is allocated every year to purchase more books and journals for the general library. This academic year, the college has allocated Rs. 200,000 for the purchase of reference books and journals to benefit students and research scholars. The books and journals have been procured and added to the library, which will provide students with a wide range of resources to enhance their learning and research.

Motivate Faculties & Students to Apply for Funding Projects: The college administration is motivating faculties to apply for funding projects to support research and development activities. The college is providing necessary resources and support for the faculties to apply for funding projects. This year 3 students applied for funding projects and they got awarded.

Establish a GIS Laboratory: The college administration has planned to establish a GIS laboratory to enable students to develop skills in these emerging fields and promote innovative research. We are waiting for the approval and funds from the Government of Tamil Nadu for further action.

Establish a Separate Library for Civil Services: The placement cell maintained a separate stock of books for the students who preparing for the civil service examinations to provide students with relevant information and resources.

Overall, the college administration is committed to addressing the feedback from the faculty and implementing the necessary improvements to enhance the academic programs and facilities. The college is continuously monitoring the progress and making necessary adjustments to ensure that students receive the best education possible.

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

Based on the faculty feedback for the academic year 2020-2021 at Arignar Anna Government Arts College, Namakkal, the overall feedback for the college has been positive. The majority of the faculty rated the content of courses in the programme, clarity of course objectives, inclusion of advanced topics, adequacy of instructional hours, career orientation in the syllabus, availability of teaching resources and reference books, opportunity for applied learning, and appropriateness of Continuous Assessment System as very good or excellent.

However, there were some areas identified for improvement. The faculty suggested that the college needs enough classrooms and language labs, improved student extra-curricular activities, establishment of Ph.D programs in further departments, international journals, teaching of soft skills for students' career, hostel facilities for far-off students, improved necessary facilities for research, inclusion of recent optional papers, establishment of research centers in every department, increase in auditorium and classroom facilities, introduction of self-employment workshops/training, allowing students for seminars and conferences, motivation for students to study PG and research programs, and motivation for faculties to organize workshops, seminars, and conferences.

Overall, the feedback indicates that the college has been performing well but has scope for improvement in various areas, including infrastructure, facilities, and curriculum. These suggestions should be taken into consideration by the college management to improve the quality of education and facilities for the students and faculty.

Action Taken Report:

Based on the valuable feedback provided by the faculty, the following actions have been taken by the management to improve the institution:

Increase the number of classrooms and establish a language lab to enhance the learning experience: Upon our request the government of Tamil Nadu sanctioned additional building for the classrooms. The construction is in progress.

Improve student extra-curricular activities to encourage their overall development: The Department of Physical Education and the Fine Arts Club have taken several initiatives to encourage students to participate in sports and extracurricular activities. As a result, our students have excelled in various competitions and have brought many accolades and awards to the college.

Open Ph.D. programs in additional departments to promote research and higher education: The college administration submitted applications to the Directorate of Collegiate Education (DCE) for opening new Ph.D. programs in additional departments to promote research and higher education. As a result, the DCE approved the request, and a new Ph.D. program has been initiated in the Department of Zoology.

Provide access to international journals to keep faculty and students updated with the latest research and advancements in their fields: To ensure that faculty and students have access to the latest research and advancements in their fields, the institution has provided access to international journals through the digital library. The library is equipped with an internet connection and INFLIBNET subscription, allowing faculty and students to access a wide range of national and international journals and books with various titles.

Teach soft skills to students to enhance their employability and overall personality development: The comprehensive soft skills training program of our college focuses on enhancing students' communication skills, teamwork, leadership, problem-solving, and interpersonal skills. This program includes various workshops, training sessions, and seminars conducted with a professional approach. The program is designed to equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge required to succeed in their careers and personal lives.

Establish hostel facilities for students who live far away from the institution: The college administration has made a request to the Directorate of Collegiate Education (DCE) to establish a hostel for female students who live far away from the institution. The request has been approved by the Government of Tamil Nadu in principle, and the college is awaiting the final outcome.

Increase auditorium and classroom facilities to accommodate a larger student population: The college management and faculty identified the need for additional classroom and auditorium facilities to accommodate a larger student population. To address this, the college approached the local MLA for assistance. Upon our request, the MLA made a representation to the government for the sanctioning of a well-equipped auditorium and classroom facilities. The construction of the new classrooms is currently underway, and we are waiting for the sanctioning of the auditorium.

Encourage faculty members to organize workshops, seminars, and conferences to promote knowledge sharing and skill development: The college management has been actively encouraging faculty members to organize workshops, seminars, and conferences to promote knowledge sharing and skill development. As a result, the Department of Physics, the Department of Botany, and the Youth Red Cross (YRC) have organized national-level seminars during this academic year.

In conclusion, the management has taken various actions to address the suggestions provided by the faculty and improve the quality of education and facilities for the students and faculty. The management is committed to continuous improvement and will take further steps to address any further suggestions and feedback in the future.

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

Based on the faculty feedback for the year 2021-2022, the following observations can be made:

 The content of courses in the program received a mix of ratings, with a majority of respondents rating it as very good or good.

The clarity of course objectives and the inclusion of advanced topics were rated positively, but there were a few respondents who rated them as fair or poor.

 Adequacy of instructional hours received varied ratings, with a significant number of respondents rating it as fair or poor.

Career orientation in the syllabus was rated moderately, with a mix of positive and negative responses.

 The availability of teaching resources and reference books received a mixed response, with some respondents rating it positively and others rating it as fair or poor.

The opportunity for applied learning received a moderate rating, with a mix of positive and negative responses.

 The course/programme of studies carrying a sufficient number of optional papers was rated moderately, with a significant number of respondents rating it as fair or poor.

The course was perceived to have a good balance between theory and application, but there were some
respondents who rated it as fair or poor.

The appropriateness of the continuous assessment system received mixed ratings, with some respondents rating
it positively and others rating it as fair or poor.

 Facilities for research received varied ratings, with a significant number of respondents rating it positively, but there were also respondents who rated it as fair or poor.
